Learner Permit to License Application (Form CI-12)

Form CI-12 Instructions:

Student should complete Part 1. See SAMPLE on reverse side.

Part 3 is optional if the student intends to apply for voter registration or change party affiliation.

Part 1: *Fill out questions 1-14 and sign form

*Don't forget to include your permit number and date of issue in upper right-hand corner

*Home Training/Commercial Training Certification: **Parent** signs here and provides license number.

*Medical Certification: Be sure to check this section (to the right of Selective Service Consent)

*Certification of Applicant: **Student** has to sign/date here.

*Parental Consent Age 16 or 17 only: Parent has to sign/date and provide license number here.

(Age 18+ does not need Parental Consent)

When the student passes the Roads Skills Test, the Agent/Inspector will stamp and sign the pink copy of the Road Evaluation Form (R-279) and return this to the student. **The R-279 form and the active Learner Permit will allow the student to immediately drive alone after passing their test.** This temporary license allows a student to drive for a **period of 30 days** to allow their license time to be processed and sent to them.

It is the students responsibly to go to the DMV QR code **24 hours after the license test** to complete the license process. The DMV will process the license and send the license directly to the student. The student should receive their license within 10 to 20 days from the date the Driving School submits the applications.
